A pronoun takes the place of a noun, or it may replace a person's name.

A verb describes an action or a state of being.

An article comes before a noun in a sentence and is a special kind of adjective.

A preposition is used with a noun or pronoun to form a phrase.

Conjunction

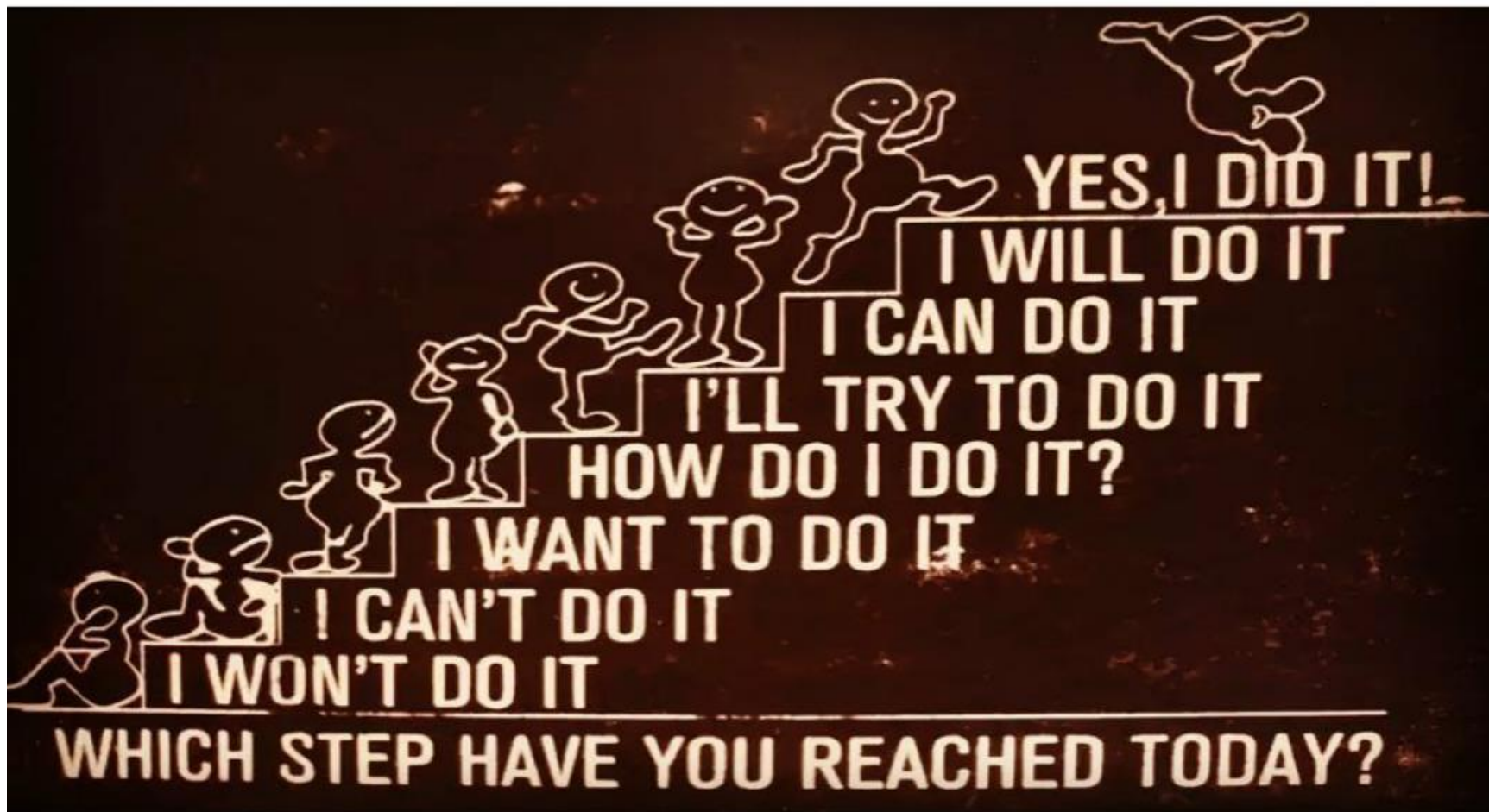
A conjunction joins words and groups of words within a sentence.
