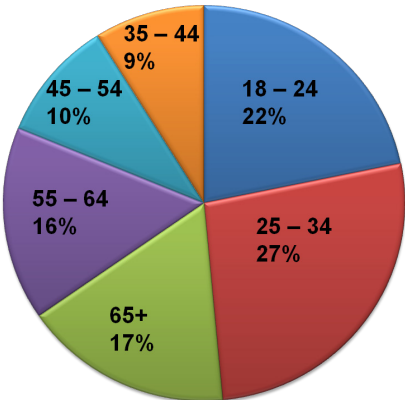




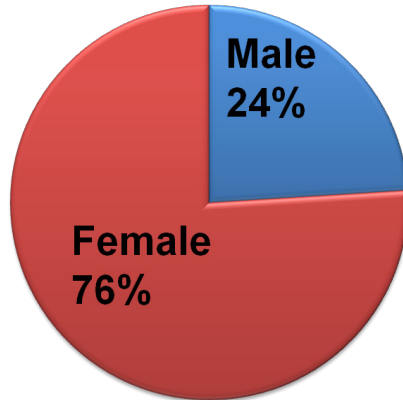

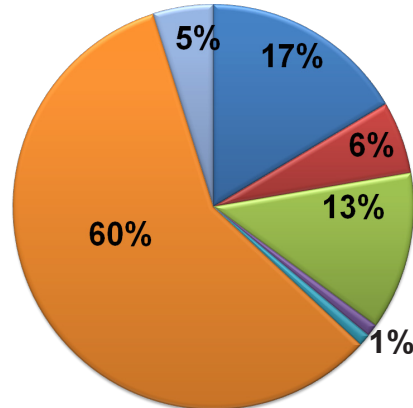
### Age
