
Survey Administration

- 279 responded (30%)


 Questions cover demographics, reasons for tutoring, program feedback, challenges, and comments



Volunteer Gender




Volunteer Age






Volunteer Ethnicity







Regions Where Volunteers are Active

Tenure with School on Wheels




Why our Volunteers are with School on Wheels











Communication between myself and School on Wheels is poor.


I don't have enough resources to manage my student's behavior.
