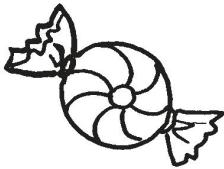

The sound you hear at the end of **drink** is **nk**.

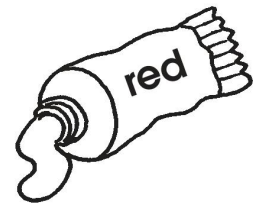
