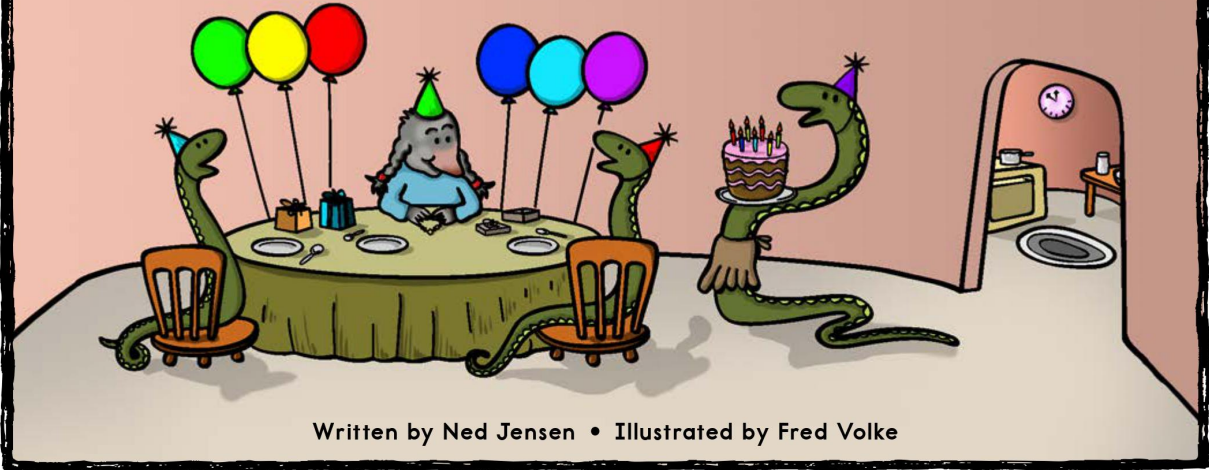

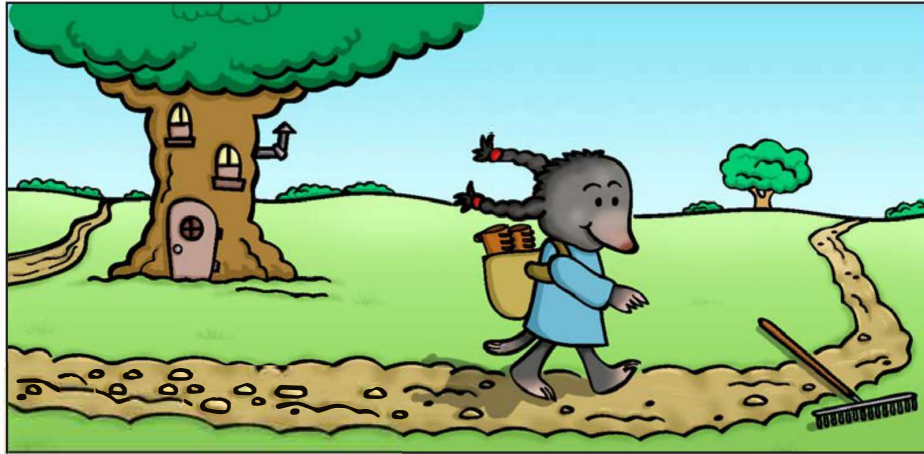

contractions; possessive apostrophe 's

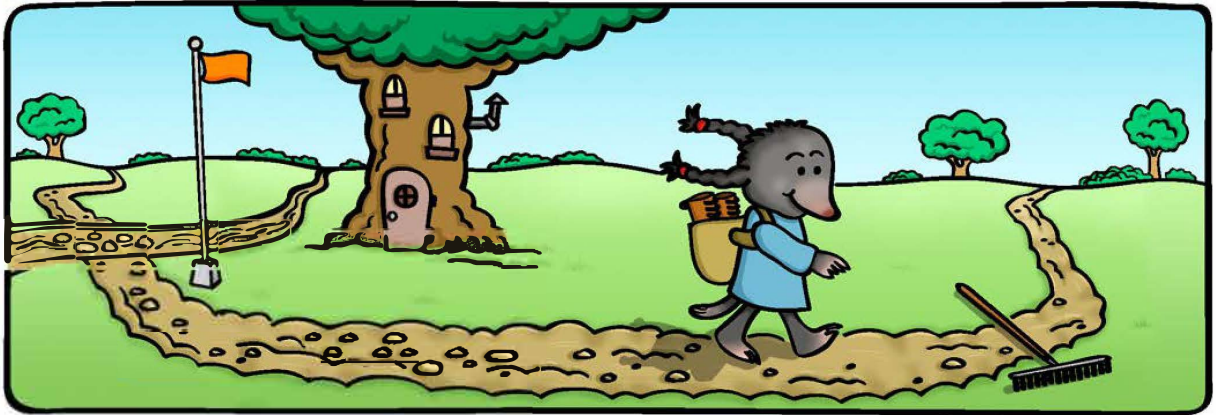


Rose the mole woke up.

Take your skates with you.”

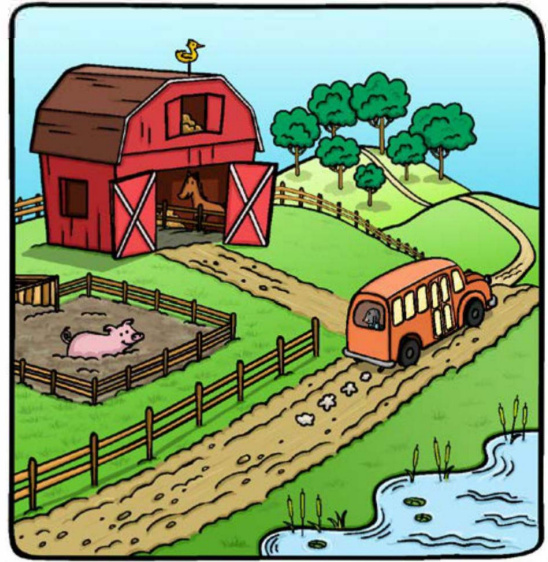


Rose put her skates in a tote.

She went past a hole.

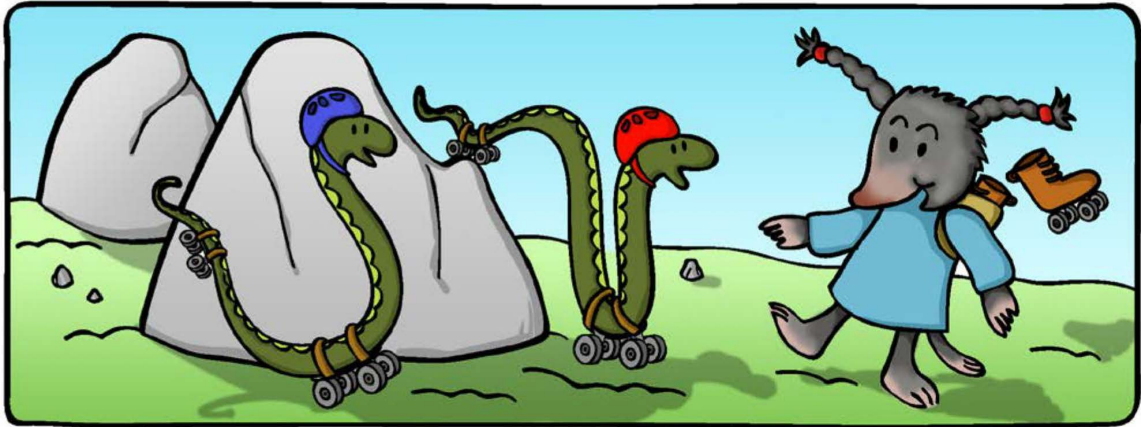


The bus came up the lane.

Rose got on the bus.

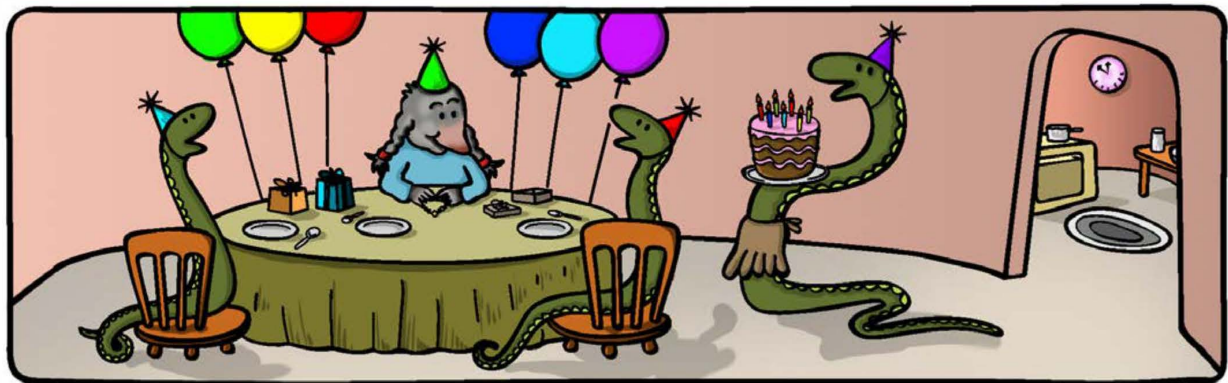
The bus smoked as
