2,500 Backpacks given to students

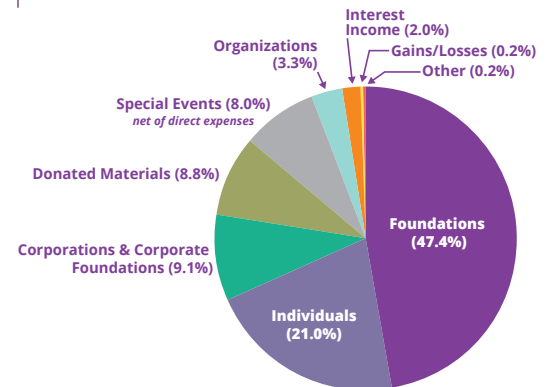
1,664 Students participated in weekly tutoring

737 Devices (laptops, tablets, hot spots) given to students

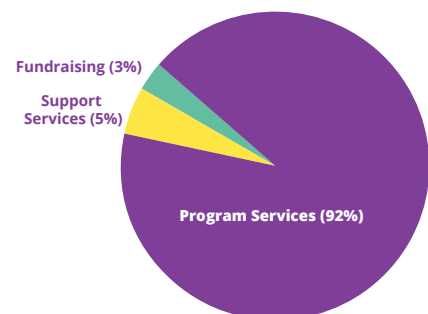

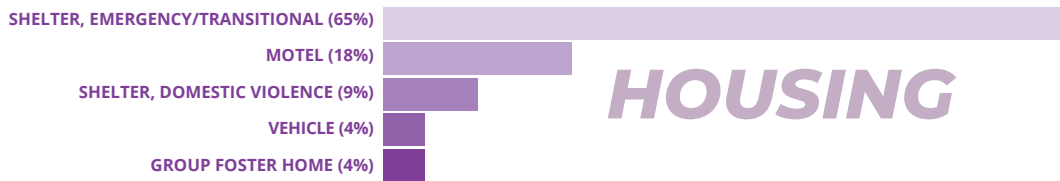
