Setting S.M.A.R.T goals in different areas will help fulfill the requirements of your chosen college application.

For example, a S.M.A.R.T. goal for a student who wants to improve their English grade might be, "I will get an A on my next English paper by making sure I

understand the assignment, letting my teacher read my draft and completing three revisions before the due date." This is a solid goal that presents clear, manageable steps for meeting a measurable objective in a specific time frame.

Use the chart below to make your goal into a S.M.A.R.T goal:
