1 in every 20 children in California does not have a home.

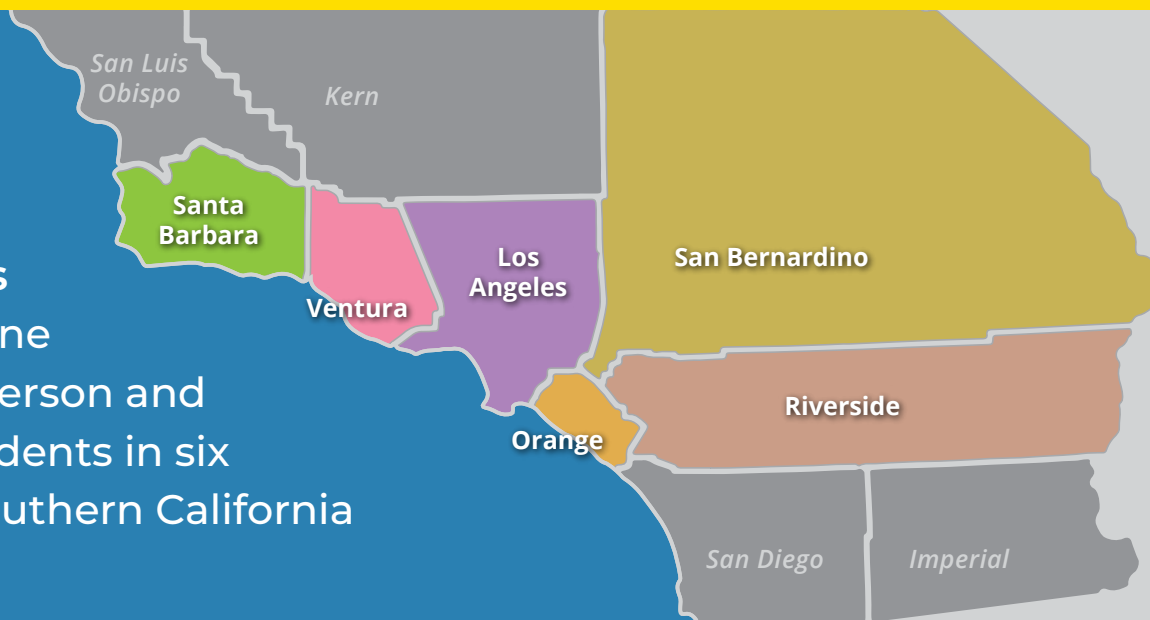
Homelessness has a devastating impact on children's educational opportunities:

- Nine times more likely to repeat a grade
- Four times more likely to drop out of school entirely

School on Wheels trains and matches volunteers with students living in shelters, motels, vehicles, group homes, and on the streets and provides:

- Free one-on-one weekly tutoring and school supplies
- Parental support
- A learning center on Skid Row
- Scholarships

School on Wheels provides one-on-one tutoring, both in person and online, for K-12 students in six counties across Southern California
