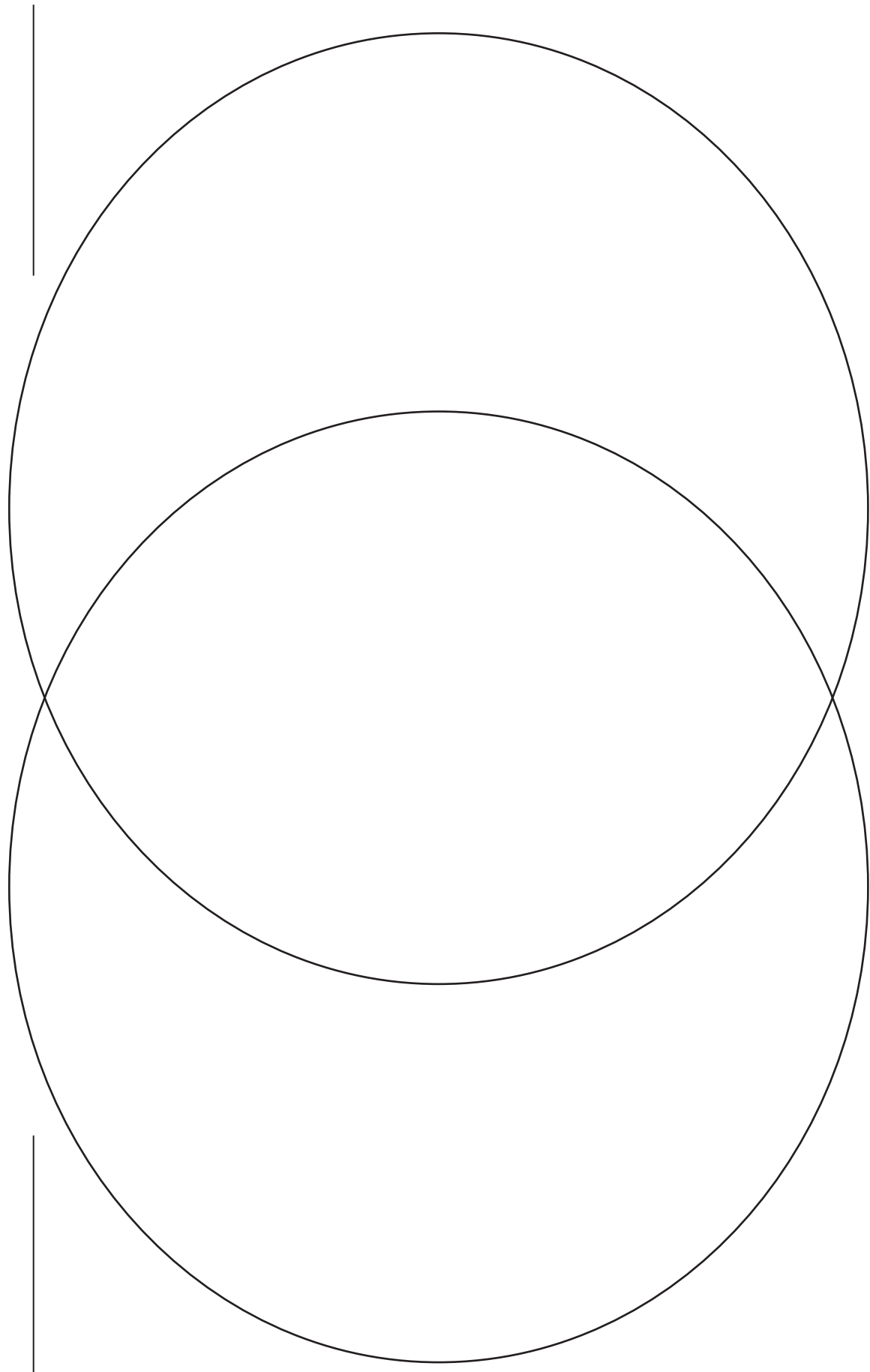

- 1 If you sit down for dinner in India, you might see rice stewed meat or vegetables.
- 2 In India, meals often include meat such as chicken or lamb legumes and yogurt-based sauces.
- 3 Curry paste coconut milk lemongrass and garlic are used to flavor many dishes in Thailand.
- 4 Cooks in Thailand often blend sweet sour salty bitter and hot flavors together in one dish.

- 6 Meat is often dried smoked salted or pickled for winter.
