

apiary
(noun)

1. People raise and protect bees in an **apiary**.
2. The bees from the **apiary** pollinate the nearby gardens.
3. The beekeeper collects honey from the hives in the **apiary**.

compromised
(adjective)

1. If something is **compromised**, it is damaged or impaired in some way.
2. When scientists looked at the sick bees, they found the bees' immune systems were **compromised**, or impaired.
3. With their security **compromised**, the army had to pull out of the area.

demise
(noun)

1. I don't want to think about anyone's **demise** because death frightens me.
2. The queen's early **demise** threw the kingdom into chaos.
3. The invention of cars led to the **demise** of regular train travel.

disorder
(noun)

1. The word *disorder* refers to a physical or mental condition in which things aren't working right.
2. The boy was stung by a bark scorpion and now suffers from a movement **disorder**.
3. Acid reflux is a digestive **disorder**, or condition, that causes digestive juices in the stomach to back up.

pollinate
(verb)

1. Bees, butterflies, and other insects **pollinate**, or fertilize, many types of plants.
2. When plants **pollinate**, they transfer pollen from one plant to another.
3. Plants **pollinate** each other in order to begin the reproductive process.

sanctuary
(noun)

1. A wildlife **sanctuary** is a protected place where animals can live without being hunted.
2. An elephant **sanctuary** is a place where retired circus and zoo elephants can peacefully live out their lives.
3. The girl came to this country to find **sanctuary**, or refuge, from the violence in her country.
