Summer Olympics Legends



CHECK-IN ACTIVITY

Ask your student who in their life deserves a gold medal.

OR

Ask your student how their day is going by giving it a bronze medal, silver medal, or gold medal.

Note: No activity works for every student. If your student is uncomfortable with these activities, it is ok to move on.

Review the last lesson

- Ex. Ask your student: What do you remember from our last lesson?
- Ex. Ask your student: Do you have any questions before we move on?

Review goals for today:

- Ex. Tell your student: Today, we're going to read a story about amazing athletes in one of the biggest athletic competitions in the world. What's your favorite sport or hobby? Do you have a favorite athlete?

SESSION REVIEW AND PREVIEW

Assist with homework if any. However, if short on time, priority should be given to the academic program because it aligns with the student's current learning level.

Read "Summer Olympics Legends": Spend 10 minutes reading this story with your student. While reading, ask questions about the characters, settings, and props. Keep a dictionary of new words your student encounters in the story and review it after reading.

"Summer Olympics Legends" worksheet: Spend 10 minutes working on this worksheet (Refer back to the story as needed). Do the quiz check with your student if time permits.

You can also check out the "Summer Olympics Legends" lesson plan for more detailed guidance about how to navigate the story with your student.

HOMEWORK HELP

ACADEMIC PROGRAM ACTIVITY

Note: Some students might finish activities very quickly, and some might need more time. Start with the first activity, and continue to others as time allows. After 20 minutes, move on to the "break" activity.

Try out some Olympic sports exercises. For example, do swimmer arm circles, soccer player high knees, track star running in place.
